#### He Is Risen! He Is Risen Indeed! Alleluia!

So many times we think of those words as the traditional Easter greeting that we share with each other on the morning we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord. If I was a betting man I would be willing to bet you that you haven't been greeted that way since Easter morning. This thought came to mind today - "Why do we only greet each other like that on Easter morning?" It honestly is a greeting that we can joyfully share with not only on Easter Sunday, but every Sunday. Throughout the remainder of the season of Easter within the church and every other day of the year, let us remember that it is not just on Easter Sunday that we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, but that it is EVERY DAY that we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. If it were not for the resurrection we would be a people without hope and a people with an empty and unfocused faith.

Jesus IS risen, and now reigns as our risen King of Kings for eternity. This is not only good news but the best news that we could ever possibly receive.
